

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FOREIGN EUROPEAN STUDENTS ENROLING IN MASTER'S OR ADVANCED MASTER'S PROGRAMS AT ULG

Scholarship for European students (or assimilate) wishing to enroll in a master's or complementary master's program at ULg.

Duration: one or two years (depending on the master's program); one year (advanced master's)

2016-2017 academic year

Objective:

Approximately twenty scholarships will be allocated for the 2016-2017 academic year in order to:

- To support financially students having a personal study project, in adequation with a specific and original Master of the ULg, in the spirit of the student's mobility within the Bologna space
- strengthen links with partner institutions, proposing curriculum complementarities which could result to a joint degree.

Practical details:

The funds are allocated to European students pursuing a master's or advanced master's degree at ULg, in order to match the additional costs related to mobility.

The scholarship comprises 10 monthly payments of 500 €. If the student is enrolled in a 120 credits master's program, s/he will receive the identical amount in year two if s/he validate at least 45 credits in year one. In case of failure (less than 45 credits validated), the scholarship is stopped and the student may not apply again for this scholarship.

Also included in the scholarship is one round trip ticket per year between Belgium and the student's country of origin, (maximum: 300 € for neighbor countries, United Kingdom and Spain, and 600 € for other countries.)

Once the scholarship application has been completed, students must then register as full-time students in either a master's or advanced master's program and pay their tuition fees (835 €) before moneys can be allocated.

Eligibility:

- The applicant must not having been regularly enrolled at ULg before (excluding Erasmus or exchange programme)
- European student or assimilate¹ graduated of 1st or 2nd cycle, having been graduated for 3 years maximum, or in his/her last study year

¹ if the student's father, mother holds Belgian nationality; if the student's father, mother, is a permanent resident of Belgium; if the student's father, mother or the student himself or herself has been granted political refugee status; if the student's wife or husband or legal co-habitant resides in Belgium and is engaged in professional



 The applicant must follow ULg's general admission procedure. His/her completed admission application, as well as the <u>online application for the scholarship</u>, must

be received by the admission office.

 Master's and advanced masters programmes in medicine, dentistry and veterinary medicine are not eligible

Selection of candidates

Candidates will be selected by a committee comprised of administrative and academic authorities, first selection will be held in June and second selection end of August.

The eligible applications would be analyzed under academic quality criteria.

A priority will be given to applicants who successfully participated in an Erasmus programme at the ULg

Application procedure

Applications are to be submitted individually in English or French before 01/06/2016 or before 01/08/2016 and will include:

- a completed admissions application: www.ulg.ac.be/admissions; with all mandatory documents
